## The Waypoint Approach

Unlike many other recovery programs, Waypoint isn't a quick fix. It's a 12-month residential journey of regeneration and restoration, built on:



### **Biblical discipleship**

Scripture, teaching, prayer, and fellowship that ground men in their faith.



### **Grace-based curriculum**

A healing environment focused on true transformation.



### **Strategic accountability**

Men encourage and challenge each other to grow.



### **Clinical counseling**

Individual counselors walk with each man through goals and progress.



### **Job skills training**

Hands-on experience with local partners prepares residents for reintegration.

# Securing the Future of Waypoint Ministry

Phase 1 secures the long-term future of the ministry by purchasing the main facility in Dahlonega and paying off the remaining balance on the Thrift Store property. Core residential spaces and essential infrastructure will be upgraded to strengthen safety and stability, and Servant Leadership housing will be remodeled. A dedicated maintenance facility will be added, and recreation will be expanded with a recreational field, a disc golf course, and an improved hiking trail. Teaching spaces will be modernized with updated technology and furnishings to deepen engagement in the program.

## Phase 1: \$3,100,000

- ➔ Secure the long-term future of the ministry by purchasing the main Dahlonega campus and paying off the Thrift Store property balance.
- ➔ Upgrade core residential spaces and essential infrastructure to strengthen safety and stability for the men.
- ➔ Remodel Servant Leadership housing, add a maintenance facility, and enhance recreation with a recreational field, disc golf course, and improved hiking trail.
- ➔ Modernize teaching spaces with updated technology and furnishings to deepen engagement.

## Future Phase 2 Goals

After Phase 1 is complete, we will embark on the next phase to improve additional parts of the campus, including our multi-purpose building (kitchen, chapel, housing), new laundry facility, and an expanded thrift store & community space.
